
It is important that this form be completed and forwarded to me no later than August 1, 2011 in order that we may make appropriate arrangements for you and the Parade.

Note: This is the exact order that you will be judged the parade, any deviation from this line-up could result in disqualification. Final Changes must be submitted to the Parade Chairman **No Later Than** Thursday at the Uniform Units Meeting following the MASA Regular Business Meeting during the fall session.

This form is designed to assist you in completing your parade line-up in the required format and to help you to better place your units into the proper Trophy Category. Where ever you see a drop down arrow it will indicate the field is automated and will provide you with a list to choose from, just click on the arrow and select the name, this will automatically populate the field. If you do not find an appropriate entry, you may manually type in the field.

All other fields that do not have the arrow will require manual input from you.

Keep in mind that only one unit can qualify for one trophy category, therefore, if you have a unit that does not fit the descriptions listed, then you should place them into the President's Trophy Category.

This parade line-up will be provided to all Judges and Parade Marshalls and will be their tool used for judging.

Below are brief descriptions of each field.

Submission Date- Manual Input Required, Date you submitted your parade line up to the Parade Marshal. This will help separate any parade line-up revisions.

Blank Field- No Input Required, this field will be populated my MASA Parade Marshal.

Shrine Center- Automated Field, Click and Select your Shrine Center.

Shrine Center Home Location- Manual Input Required, City and State of the location of your Shrine Center.

Shrine Center Hotel Name/Location- Manual Input Required, Type the name of the hotel and location your Shrine Center will be Headquartered during the MASA Fall Convention. Location can be in general terms such as street corner e.g. "Atlantic and 19th Street".

Shrine Center Hotel Phone Number- Manual Input Required, Type the Phone Number of the hotel your Shrine Center will be headquartered during the Fall MASA Convention.

Year Chartered- Manual Input Required, The year your Shrine Center was chartered, your Recorder can provide you with this.

Total Members- Manual Input Required, Total number of members as of the end of the previous calendar year as reported to the Imperial Council, your Recorder can provide you with this. Any discrepancies will be ratified by the current MASA Yearbook.

Potentate- Manual Input Required, First and Last Name or First Name, Middle Initial and Last Name, or Full Name, this will be used for introductions at the reviewing stand.

Chief Rabban- Manual Input Required, First and Last Name or First Name, Middle Initial and Last Name, or Full Name, this will be used for introductions at the reviewing stand.

Assistant Rabban- Manual Input Required, First and Last Name or First Name, Middle Initial and Last Name, or Full Name, this will be used for introductions at the reviewing stand.

Oriental Guide- Manual Input Required, First and Last Name or First Name, Middle Initial and Last Name, or Full Name, this will be used for introductions at the reviewing stand.

Treasurer- Manual Input Required, First and Last Name or First Name, Middle Initial and Last Name, or Full Name, this will be used for introductions at the reviewing stand.

Recorder- Manual Input Required, First and Last Name or First Name, Middle Initial and Last Name, or Full Name, this will be used for introductions at the reviewing stand.

Head of Units- Manual Input Required, First and Last Name or First Name, Middle Initial and Last Name, or Full Name, this will be used for introductions at the reviewing stand. Also include a Cell Phone Number in the space available if applicable.

Instruction Page

Unit Name- Automated Field, Click and Select. If your unit is missing you can overwrite the field and the Parade Marshal will correct the form.

Unit Head Name- Manual Input, First and Last Name or First Name, Middle Initial and Last Name, or Full Name, this will be used for introductions at the receiving stand.

Title- Automated Field, Click and Select. If your Title is missing you can overwrite the field and the parade Marshal will correct the form.

Trophy Category- Automated Field, Click and Select. It is very important that you select the proper trophy category, this is what the Judges and Parade Marshals will use to gauge you during the parade. A Unit could be disqualified if a category does not match the unit. Trophy Categories are as followed;

4. Street Map of Assembly Area

Changes to the Parade Orders concerning the penalty system were approved by the MASA Officers and the Uniformed Units Association at the MASA Spring Meeting held in Pittsburgh, PA, April 14, 2010.

IMPORTANT

Please note the following instructions relate to the penalty system and should be fully understood.

1. Each unit exceeding 40 feet distance between units as required in the Parade Orders, will be given a warning in the early part of the parade by the Parade Marshals.
2. If the unit has not corrected this spacing at a point further in the parade, that unit will be identified on a score sheet by a second group of Parade Marshals. This will cause a two point deduction from the total score for that unit as assigned by the National Judges Association and a one point deduction against the Shrine Center on each unit violation.
3. If a Temple exceeds 80 feet between Shrine Centers as required by the Parade Orders, they will be penalized one point from their total score for the Outstanding Temple.
4. All motorized units will be required to have a point vehicle or person whose sole purpose is to maintain the 40 foot spacing with the unit in front.
5. They will also be required to have a rear vehicle/person who will maintain a predetermined distance between the point vehicle.
6. The distance between the point vehicle/person and the rear vehicle will be the space allowed for street maneuvers for that unit.
7. Since motor units are of different sizes, it will be the duty of the rear vehicle/person to set the proper distance for that unit. Excessive or unnecessary space could cause a two point penalty. If the rear vehicle/person stops to allow maneuvering while the parade is moving forward, it will be considered a violation and penalty.
8. No motorized unit shall be located in the first or last position of the Shrine Center lineup; unless there are no other type units involved.

NOTE: Every effort will be made by the Parade Marshals to determine whether a Unit or Shrine Center is at fault for causing a parade gap.

DATE: SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 10, 2011

TIME: 9:30 A.M.

ASSEMBLY AREA AND REPORTING TIME:

Areas are designated and time indicated for each Shrine Center on attached sheets. Assembly time 30 minutes prior to takeoff time. Potentate will be responsible for his Units being at the designated parade assembly area at the time specified.

ROUTE OF MARCH:

North on Atlantic Avenue from 17th Street to 29th Street, a distance of approximately 1.5 miles.

DISPERSAL AREA:

29th Street; between Atlantic & Pacific Avenues. Pick up trucks, buses, etc. should park on East side (Ocean side) of Pacific Ave., starting at 29th and Pacific. Move out of area as quickly as possible to allow room for the next Shrine Center.

REVIEWING STAND:

East side of Atlantic Avenue at 25th Street.

SALUTES:

Each element in the parade will execute but One (1) Salute. This will be at the Reviewing Stand.

COLOR GUARDS:

The first colors from each Shrine Center to proceed through the judging area will be judged as the Shrine Center Color Guard and they must be under-guard.

PARADE INTERVALS:

Shrine Center Units:

Intervals of 80 feet between Shrine Centers, and 40 feet between Units, are to be constantly maintained.

Motorized Units

No motorized unit shall be located in the first or last position of the Shrine Center lineup - unless there are no other type units involved.

Cadence:

The Marching Cadence will be 110 steps per minute. **EXCEPTION: PIPE BANDS ARE PERMITTED TO SLOW MARCH IN JUDGING AREA ONLY.**

PARADE MARSHALS:

Marshals will be stationed along the parade route for your assistance in case of need and to direct any orders to any Shrine Center or its Units from the Parade Marshal or the Director General. They will request that proper intervals be kept as well as see that all parade orders are adhered to by those in line of march.

FLOATS AND MOVING EQUIPMENT:

All floats and display vehicles shall comply with all requirements in construction as set forth in the Imperial By-Laws. All materials used in the construction of the floats must be either fireproof or fire-resistant and all must have the required safety equipment needed to safeguard the parade spectators.

All Floats shall have at least a minimum visibility of 180 degrees with 90 degrees on either side of a center line of the float. All vehicles in parade must adhere to this order.

MOTOR PATROLS:

Motor Cycle and Scooter Unit riders will not be required to use helmets as required by the State of Virginia Law for the parade. Unlicensed vehicles should be transported to the starting point of the parade and from the end of parade. If this is not possible, unlicensed vehicles should travel in a group under an escort (motor cycle) from your Shrine Center.

HORSE PATROLS:

All Horse Patrol Units **must furnish immediate clean-up-crews following the Unit.**

TEMPLE MARSHALS/HEADS OF UNIT MEETING:

The Colonel/Director of Units (or his representative) of each Shrine Center and the Head of each Unit Association are required to attend a meeting with the Parade Chairman and Judges on Thursday, September 8, 2011 at the Pavilion, Virginia Beach Convention Center at 2:30 P.M. **or immediately after the business meeting.** The purpose of this meeting is to fully understand the parade orders and receive any special instructions. Please submit your final parade line-up list at this meeting if you have made any changes. A typed list would be preferred. **NOTE:** Meeting location, Suite 3ABC, 2nd Floor (New Center)

BUS PERMITS:

Charter buses coming into Virginia Beach, Virginia are not required to obtain a local permit.

CARS:

1. No Shrine Center shall have more than one (1) Official Car in the parade. The car to be occupied by the Potentate (and Divan if the Potentate so desires), with no more than five (5) Nobles, including the driver, in a car. Potentate to furnish his own car and driver. No other cars will be allowed.
2. All cars carrying dignitaries and Potentates will stop in front of Reviewing Stand to allow Passengers to disembark.
3. Shrine Centers having R.V. Units will be allowed only one R.V. in the parade to represent that Unit.
4. Tractor trailers and support vehicles desiring to use the parade route must follow behind the last Shrine Center in the parade and trailing the police escort.

NOTE: The year beside each temple indicates the year that temple is last in the parade line up. The following year that temple rotates to the position behind the temple with the highest gain in membership.

PLEASE NOTE: Almas Shrine Center **Increased NINETY FIVE (95) NEW Members in 2010.**

PARADE DISCIPLINE:

1. ANY SHRINE CENTER NOT READY TO STEP INTO THE LINE OF MARCH AT THE DESIGNATED TIME AUTOMATICALLY WILL BE REQUIRED TO FALL IN AT THE END OF THE PARADE.
2. Unnecessary halting or delays prohibited. **All parade movements must be forward at all times. Proper spacing must be maintained.** This applies to all types of Units.
3. **Non-Shriners**, women, children or female impersonators, Nubian slaves or any one impersonating a person of a different race will not be allowed. Any violation of this could disqualify the Shrine Center.
4. No beverage, alcoholic or otherwise, is permitted to be consumed during a parade, whether you are parading or just watching the parade when dressed as a Noble with Fez.
5. The use of cannons, fire crackers, water pistols or any other objectionable items will not be permitted at anytime.
6. No vehicle shall be equipped with either flashing lights or sirens which would be in violation of Virginia State Law.
7. Neither candy nor other objects shall be thrown to spectators along the parade route.
8. If the above items do not include all the rules, general orders and edits of the Imperial Council Sessions, this paragraph is intended to include all of these regulations.

MASA parade trophies and plaques will be presented to the winners at the President's Banquet, Saturday, September 10, 2011.

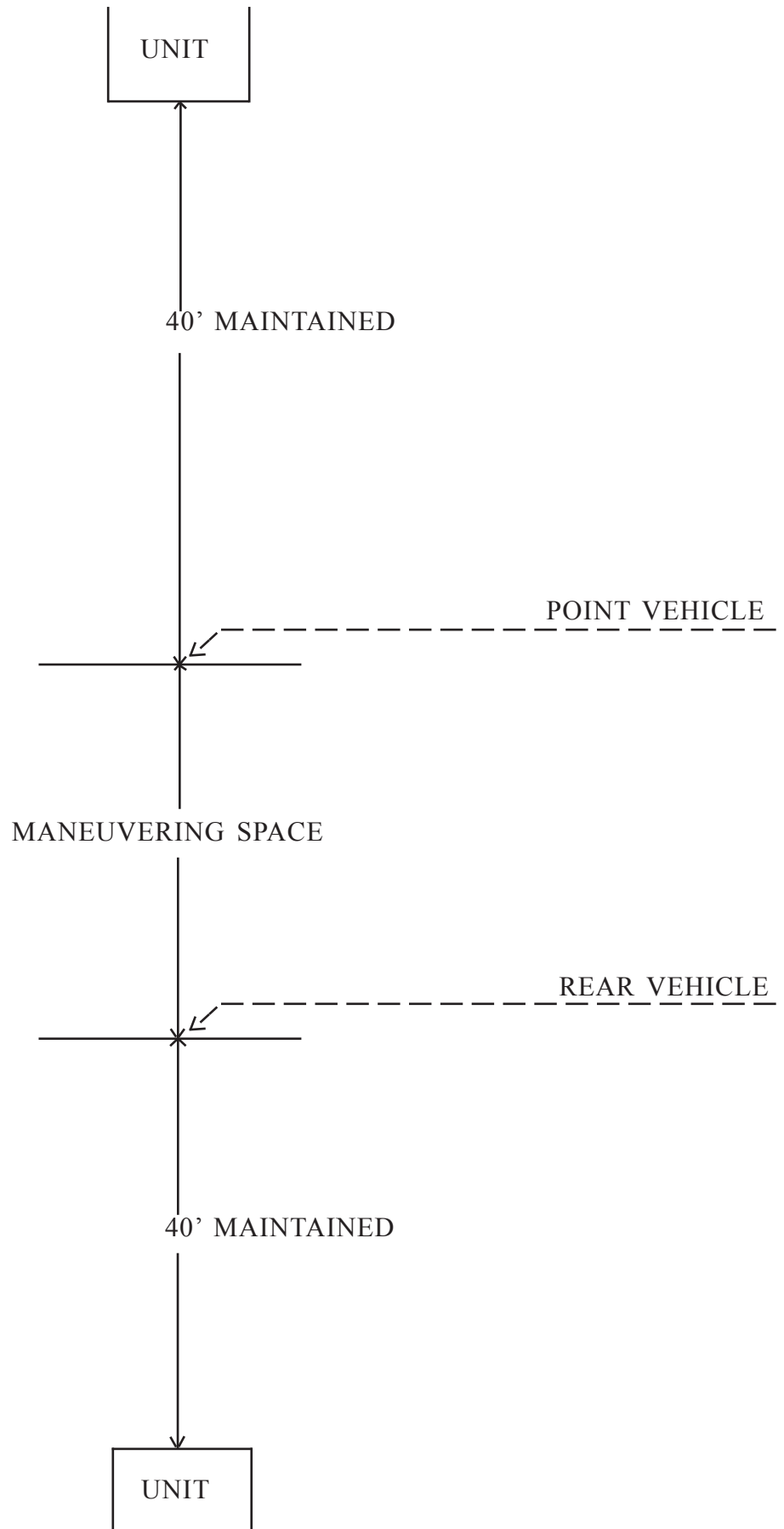
COMPETITION AWARDS:

The judging, by the National Judges Association, for the Unit Association trophies will be based on the rules formulated entirely by the Association involved. 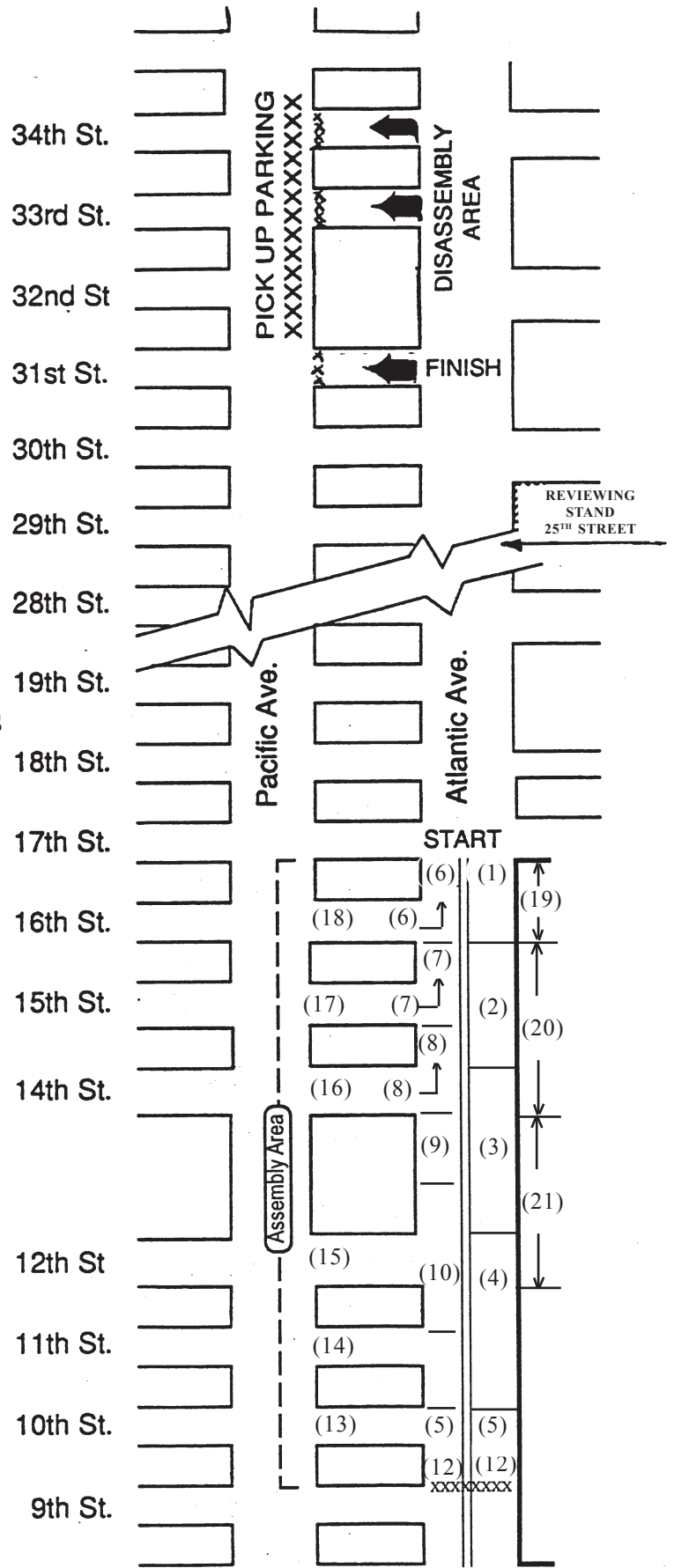
